**Academic Scholarship Application**

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The Bethune-Cookman University Orange County Alumni Chapter will award \$1,000 academic scholarships for the 2019 - 2020 academic school year to a resident of Orange County who is a Bethune-Cookman University student. The scholarship must be used to pay for tuition/fees at Bethune-Cookman University.

Applicants who meet the following criteria will be considered for the scholarship.

**DEADLINE: June 14, 2019**

**Qualifications:**

- Applicant must be an incoming freshman only at Bethune-Cookman University.
- Applicant must be formally admitted and enrolled full time into a degree-seeking program at Bethune-Cookman University by the start of the Fall 2019 semester.
- Applicant must be an Orange County Florida resident and Orange County, Florida High School Graduate.
- Applicant must be enrolled in the semester for which the award is made.
- Incoming freshman applicant must have a 3.0 GPA or higher and an official high school transcript must be submitted.

**Forfeiture of Award:**

- Does not enroll full-time in the semester in which the award is to be in effect.
- Is placed on academic and/or disciplinary probation.
- Does not meet satisfactory academic progress.
- No longer meets the scholarship qualifications.

**Applicant Procedure:**

- Complete the Academic Scholarship Application Form.
- Attach a resume of your work experience (including summer employment/volunteer community service) over the past year.
- Attach a personal essay. The personal essay should be no more than 500 words and describe your educational goals and objectives, your plans for utilizing your education after you receive your degree, and your specific qualifications for this scholarship. Be specific about the reasons you chose a Bethune-Cookman College education.
- Attach two original letters of recommendation.
- Applications must be received and postmarked by June 14, 2019. All late or incomplete applications will be disqualified. Please no fancy binders, folders, tabs, etc. These will be discarded and only requested materials will be forwarded to the selection committee.
